Application Process

Selection Process

- 1. QP's Play Reading Committee will review all submissions.
- 2. If the play is selected by the PRC to be short-listed as one of the Final 12, it will be submitted to the Board of Directors for approval. The BOD will schedule a time to meet with each applicant in **December/January** so that they may pitch their idea in detail and elaborate on this application.
- 3. The BOD will deliberate each recommended show and approve or reject them via a majority vote. The BOD reserves the right to seek external solutions not limited to previously-submitted entries.
- 4. The BOD will notify all directors of updates related to their submissions in January including any informational follow-up requests. Once all directors have been contacted regarding final decisions, and all rights are obtained, the approved season will be publicly announced via social media, newsletter, and QP's website.
